Cooking since the age of four, Duff is influenced in the kitchen by his family of great cooks and artists. His professional career began when he started working for an acclaimed Baltimore chef while attending the University of Maryland, Baltimore County. After graduating, Duff left Baltimore to study at the Culinary Institute of America in Napa Valley, California. He moved around the country studying under internationally acclaimed pastry chefs until 2000, when he returned to Baltimore to open Charm City Cakes. Duff's success has since skyrocketed and Charm City Cakes has grown to a staff of eleven friends who make phenomenal cakes.
