The show will take place in Cole Field House on Thursday October 19<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:30 p.m. with a pep rally. Students can purchase tickets starting Thursday October 5<sup>th</sup> at the Hoff Ticket Office in the Stamp Student Union with an UM ID for \$5 bowl seats and \$10 floor seats. Tickets for the general public can be purchased at the Hoff Ticket Office in the Stamp Student Union or at any Ticketmaster location for \$20 bowl seats and \$30 floor seats.

Wayne Brady, multitalented actor, singer and dancer, is presently the host of "Celebrity Duets" on Fox. Additionally, Brady can be seen in the Screen Gems feature, "Crossover", also starring Anthony Mackie. For two years, Brady has been the host of "The Wayne Brady Show," which earned him two Emmys for *Outstanding Talk Show Host*. Brady is best known for his sidesplitting improvisational skills on "Whose Line Is It Anyway?" It was on this show that Brady won an Emmy and earned four Emmy nominations.

Brady can be seen in the independent feature "I'mPerfect" and *Roll Bounce* for Fox Searchlight. His voiceover roles include "The Adventures of Brer Rabbit," "Stuart Little 3: Call of the Wild," and *Foodfight!* for Lions Gate which will be released in 2007. Some television appearances Brady has made include "Chappelle's Show," "Kevin Hill" and "The Drew Carey Show." Additionally, Brady also starred in "Flirt," a pilot for the CW network. Last year, Brady finished a run playing Billy Flynn in the Broadway production of *Chicago*.
