Ron Jeremy's career in the pornography industry began in 1978 when his girlfriend sent in a picture to "Playgirl" magazine for the "Boy Next Door" section. He received a great deal of attention from this debut and was contacted by hardcore producers to appear in on-screen productions. Jeremy's first movie was "Tigresses...And Other Man-Eaters." With the success of the movie, Jeremy quit his teaching job and joined the pornography industry full time. Jeremy has expanded his work by appearing on talk shows such as "Jerry Springer" and has consulted on projects such as "Boogie Nights," "9 1/2 Weeks" and the documentary "Heidi Fleiss: Hollywood Madam." He can also be seen in "Killing Zoe" and "Detroit Rock City."

Craig Gross is the founder and pastor of XXXchurch.com. Gross created this website after seeing some issues with the pornography industry. The Web site provides visitors with free accountability software, practical and spiritual solutions to pornography issues and weekly updates about the pornography industry. Gross's ministry practices are apart of an award winning documentary and reality TV show. He has been seen in "GQ" magazine, LA Times and The New York Times as well as on "Good Morning America," Newsweek and CNN. Gross has a book being released this month titled "Porn...The Dirty Little Secret."
