Student Entertainment Events is pleased to announce Virgin College Mega Tour featuring Talib Kweli, Sugarcult and William Tell on Thursday April 19<sup>th</sup>. Doors for this event will open at 6 p.m. and the event will start at 7 p.m. in Cole Field House. Tickets for those with a UM ID are \$10 for bowl seats and \$15 floor seats at the Union Ticket Office. The general public can purchase tickets for \$15 for bowl seats and \$20 for floor seats at any Ticket Master location.

Brooklyn bred rapper, Talib Kweli, will provide concert-goers with songs from *Ear Drum*, his first album released on Warner Bros. Records and his own label, Blacksmith Music. With his sixth album overall Talib hopes to educate the crowds, as well as entertain them.

“We need to challenge our audience but we also need to challenge ourselves to know that whatever our new experiences are, we can write about them, be creative and bring that to an audience without them feeling alienated,” Talib Kweli states.

Sugarcult was recently on Green Day’s *American Idiot* tour in the U.S. and Japan, appeared on the mainstage of Warped Tour and on the mainstages of UK Festivals such as Reading, Leeds and Glastonbury. Their most recent album, *Lights Out*, has sold close to a million albums.

William Tell, a former member of the band *Something Corporate* released his first solo album, titled *You Can Hold Me Down*, on March 13, 2007. The album features songs which were inspired by Tell’s childhood of listening to The Beach Boys and The Beatles.
