**Student Entertainment Events Presents: Ingrid Michaelson**

Student Entertainment Events and StampFest are pleased to announce Ingrid Michaelson as the first musical arts show of the new semester on Thursday, February 7. The event begins at 7:30 p.m. in the Colony Ballroom of the Adele H. Stamp Student Union with doors opening at 6:30 p.m. The event is free to students and they will not need tickets, but will have to present a UMID at the door. Tickets are not available for the general public.

As a Staten Island, New York native, Michaelson's musical endeavors began at age four with her first piano lesson. Inspired and supported by her mother, a sculptor, and father, a classical composer, her songwriting career blossomed after college. As she toured the country in a national theater troupe, Michaelson spent her free time composing songs that can be found on her first album, *Girls and Boys*, which she released in January 2007. She released the album on her own record label, Cabin 24 Records, and three months later she won a national songwriting award sponsored by West Virginia's Mountainstage.

Michaelson's talent was recognized by the music supervisor from "Grey's Anatomy," who asked to feature her song "Breakable" on an episode in November 2006. The career-boosting opportunity was followed by three more placements on the show, including the season finale episode. Michaelson's career as an independent artist immediately hit the fast track as her songs were featured on other national TV shows including "Kyle XY," "One Tree Hill," "Side Order of Life," and MTV's "Real World Denver," and on various commercials. Michaelson now has tour dates lined up through April.
