**Student Entertainment Events Presents: Post Secret Project**

Student Entertainment Events is pleased to announce Post Secret Project inventor Frank Warren as the first lecture event of the new semester. On February 26, Warren will present special postcards and conduct a question and answer session in the Grand Ballroom of the Adele H. Stamp Student Union. Doors for the event open at 6:30 p.m. and the lecture begins at 7 p.m. Tickets are free for students and not available for the general public. In spirit of the project, Student Entertainment Events is conducting our own Post Secret Project. Create your own anonymous secret and drop it off or mail it in to SEE. Check out our website or our event advertisements for more details. All secrets will be displayed at the event.

Inspired by a dream, Warren began the Post Secret Project in November 2004, when he handed out 3,000 postcards to strangers and invited them to write down and send him anonymous secrets. These initial secrets were exhibited in Washington, D.C. later that year, and after the first exhibition closed, word of the project spread and Warren received postcards from all over the world.

Today, Warren has received more than 150,000 postcards and they continue to come at a rate of about 1,000 per week. Every Sunday, Warren posts secrets on his award-winning website, [www.postsecret.com](http://www.postsecret.com), which has been viewed more than 100 million times. This international phenomenon has spawned three New York Times bestselling books with a fourth, *A Lifetime of Secrets*, published in October 2007. One of HarperCollins most sought after speakers, Warren has spoken at dozens of college campuses and appeared on international media including "Good Morning America," "The Today Show," CNN, BBC, CBC and NPR.
