# Access to Nyumburu Amphitheater

### HOW TO GET TO THE EVENT

- 1.**PARKING:** If needed, parking is available on campus. There is free parking for any vehicles in Lot 1 after 4PM on weekdays. It is about a seven (7) minute walk from Lot 1 to the STAMP. There is also paid parking in Union Lane Garage directly next to the STAMP. Please make sure you read all posted guidelines.
- 2.**ENTRANCE:** Please enter from the top of the stairs at Nyumburu Amphitheater. You will not be permitted to enter the venue from any other entrance except at the top of the stairs. Be mindful of ongoing construction around the building.
- 3. **EVENT LOCATION:** This event will take place in the Nyumburu Amphitheater, right outside STAMP. You will likely see signage outside directing you to the event once you arrive.

# Line-Up

#### HOW TO ENTER THE EVENT

- 1. WHEN TO ARRIVE: Line-up begins at 8:00 pm. Doors will open at 8:15 pm. The event begins at 9:00 pm. Doors close at 9:30 pm. You may arrive anytime between 8:00 pm and 9:30 pm. Early line-up will not be permitted.
- 2. **LINE-UP LOCATION:** Lineup will begin at the top of the stairs at Nyumburu Amphitheater. Event staff will be on-site, in addition to signage, to help you find your way.

# Event Entry HULES

- 1. A VALID ID: To enter the event, each person must present their own UID
  - a.If presenting a UMD ID, a valid University of Maryland ID (Student, faculty, and staff) must be shown upon entering the venue.
  - **b**.If you are an alumni, proof of being a UMD alumni (old UMD ID, alumni association membership) must be shown along with their ticket
- **2.ENTRY POLICY**: Line up **DOES NOT guarantee entry** as seats will be first come, first serve. Please arrive early to ensure access to the event.







# Safety Guidelines

#### PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY!

- 1. **RE-ENTRY:** Re-entry is permitted for this event. Bathrooms and water fountains will be available in STAMP next to the venue.
- 2.**FOOD & DRINK**: Outside food and drink is prohibited at this event with the exception of medical/religious exemptions.
- 3. **BAG POLICY: Please see below for permitted bags.** There will be no storage areas at the event for bags. The only exception will be for medical bags.
- 4. **WEAPONS:** Weapons in any form (including, but not limited to: pepper spray, knives, scissors) are prohibited.
- 5. **PHOTO & VIDEO:** Professional photography or video recording of any kind is strictly prohibited during the event. Professional cameras/equipment are prohibited. Only preapproved press representatives are permitted to take photographs.
- 6. APPROACHING THE STAGE/TALENT: Please do not approach the stage or talent. For event safety, talent safety, and your safety, we ask that you do not approach the stage unless directed by SEE staff to do so.
- 7. **ATTENDEE EXPECTATIONS:** By attending this event, you are agreeing to follow the Student Code of Conduct. Please be respectful of the other attendees the event, staff ensuring safety, and technicians running the event.
- 8. **COVID-19:** As it stands with University COVID-19 guidelines, mask usage is at your discretion, but is strongly encouraged for an event of this size.



# Event FAQs WE'RE HERE TO HELP!

Q: Do I need a ticket?

A: No, this event is not ticketed. However, that means this event is first come, first served as there is a capacity limit in the venue.

Q: Do I need a my UMD UID?


A: Yes, UID's are required for entrance into this event. Make sure to bring your UID and have it out when you move through the line.

Q: I accidentally brought my bag to the event, where can I leave it?

A: Unfortunately there is nowhere to put your bag securely in the STAMP. We kindly ask you to return it to your residence hall or car.

Q: I have questions day-of, who should I talk to?

A: If you see a SEE director In THIS polo, feel free to go up to them and ask them questions! They will be your day-of event experts.







Q: Will there be food and drinks at the event?

A: Water fountains are available inside STAMP. Outside food and drink is not permitted (except for medical/religious reasons).

Q: Can I sit where I want?

A: With the exception of reserved seats, ALL seats are first come, first served.
